

Yonkers' Boyce Thompson Center signs three new tenants

All three medical-services providers are tenants in other Simone properties.

The major health care tenants at the Boyce Thompson Center are St. John's Riverside Hospital and the Westmed Medical Group. Major non-health tenants include the Fortina restaurant and Starbucks.
