

Fresh & Co. to open first Westchester location at Boyce Thompson Center in Yonkers

More food options are coming to the [Boyce Thompson Center](#) in Yonkers.

[Fresh & Co.](#), a NYC-based chain offering chef-inspired organic seasonal food such as salads, soups, sandwiches, and quinoa bowls, will open sometime in the first quarter of 2019, joining other food retailers such as ISO Japanese Restaurant, Fortina Restaurant, The Taco Project and Starbucks.

This is the chain's 21st location and the first in Westchester. Currently it can be found at numerous spots throughout New York City.

The eatery, which will offer vegetarian, vegan and gluten-free menu options, has signed a lease on a 2,160-square-foot space in the center at 1084 N. Broadway.

“We are delighted that Fresh & Co. has chosen the Boyce Thompson Center for its first location in Westchester County,” said Joanna Simone, vice president of leasing and property management operations for Simone Development Cos., the owner and manager of the Boyce Thompson Center. “The addition of Fresh & Co. further enhances the outstanding roster of retail tenants at our center.”

With the signing of the lease for Fresh & Co, the Boyce Thompson Center’s retail space is fully occupied. Other tenants include Executive Wine & Spirits, Family Wellness Pharmacy, Tompkins Mahopac Bank, PLUSHBLOW Salon and Ultimate Spectacle.
